

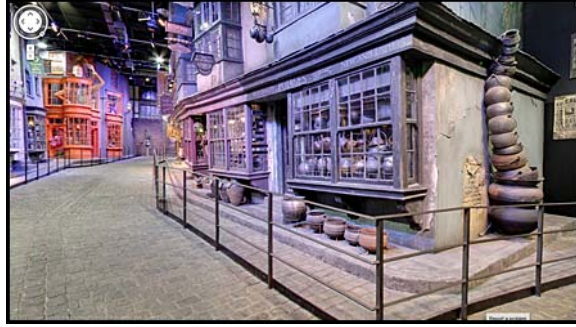

In cooperation with the Warner Bros' Harry Potter Studio Tour in Leavesden, England (Site #27 in *Harry Potter Places Book One—London and London Side-Along Apparations*), Google has *mapped* the Diagon Alley exhibit. Using Google Street View, you can STEP THROUGH the alley,



from one end to the other,



and get a close-up look at EACH of the shops.

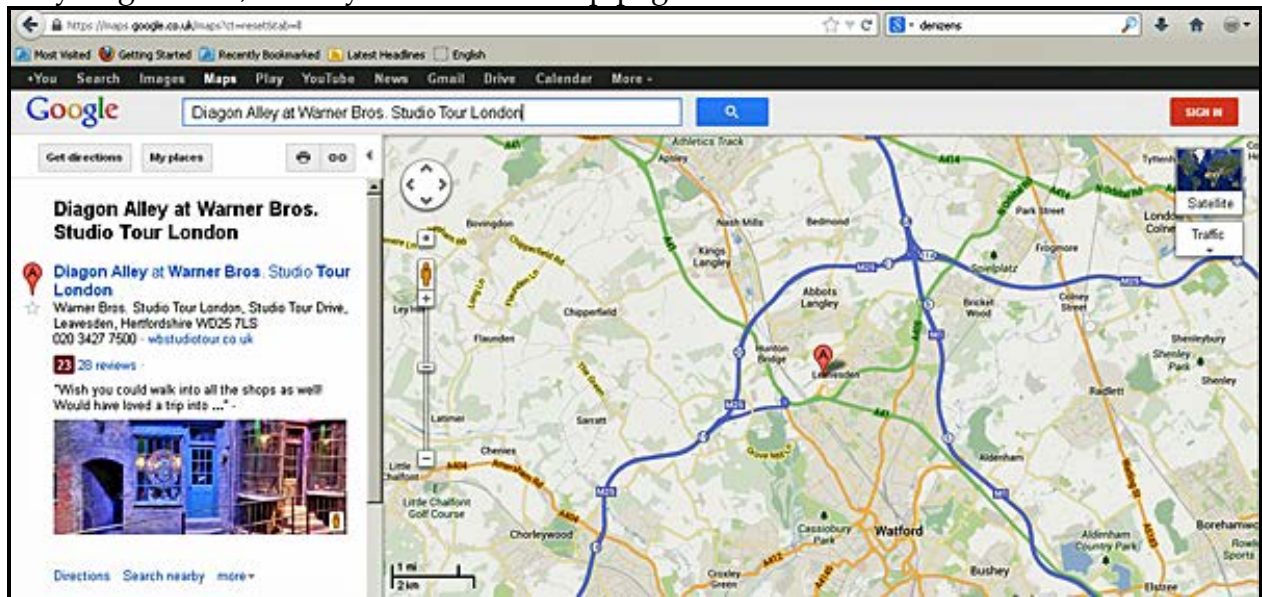

However you get there, when you reach the map page ...

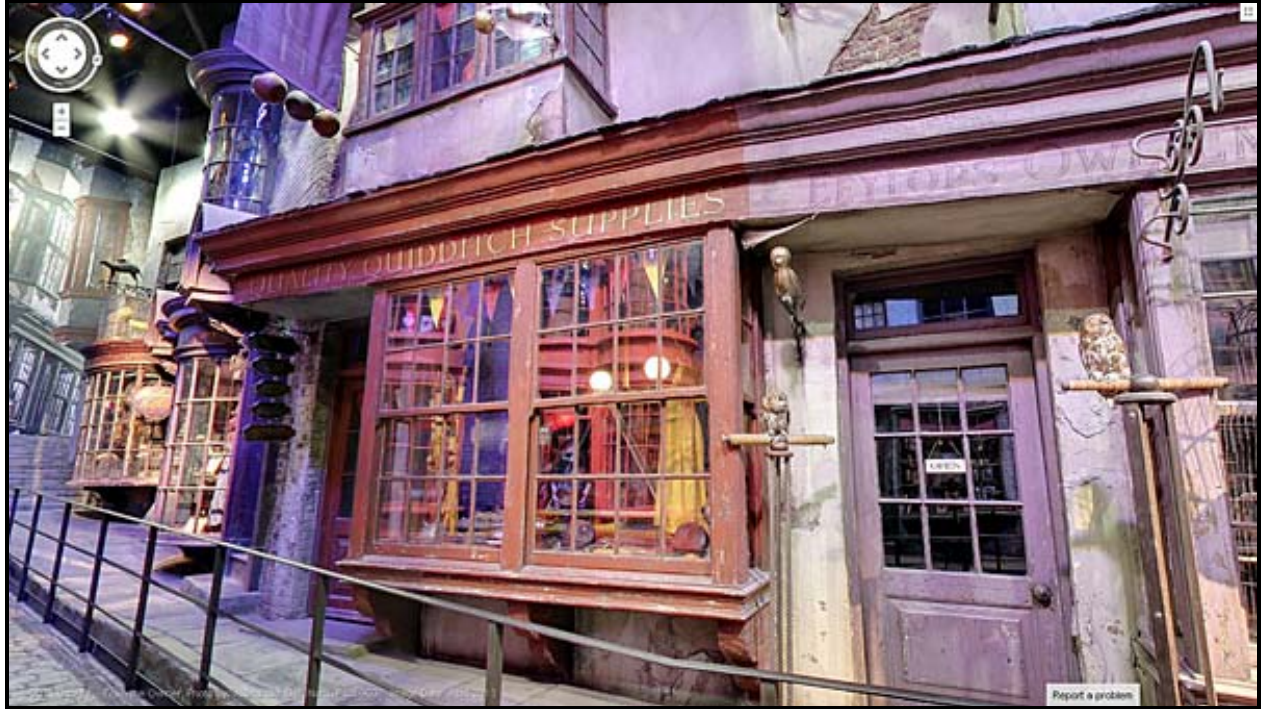


Click on the **Street View picture** at left to launch the Diagon Alley Street View function,

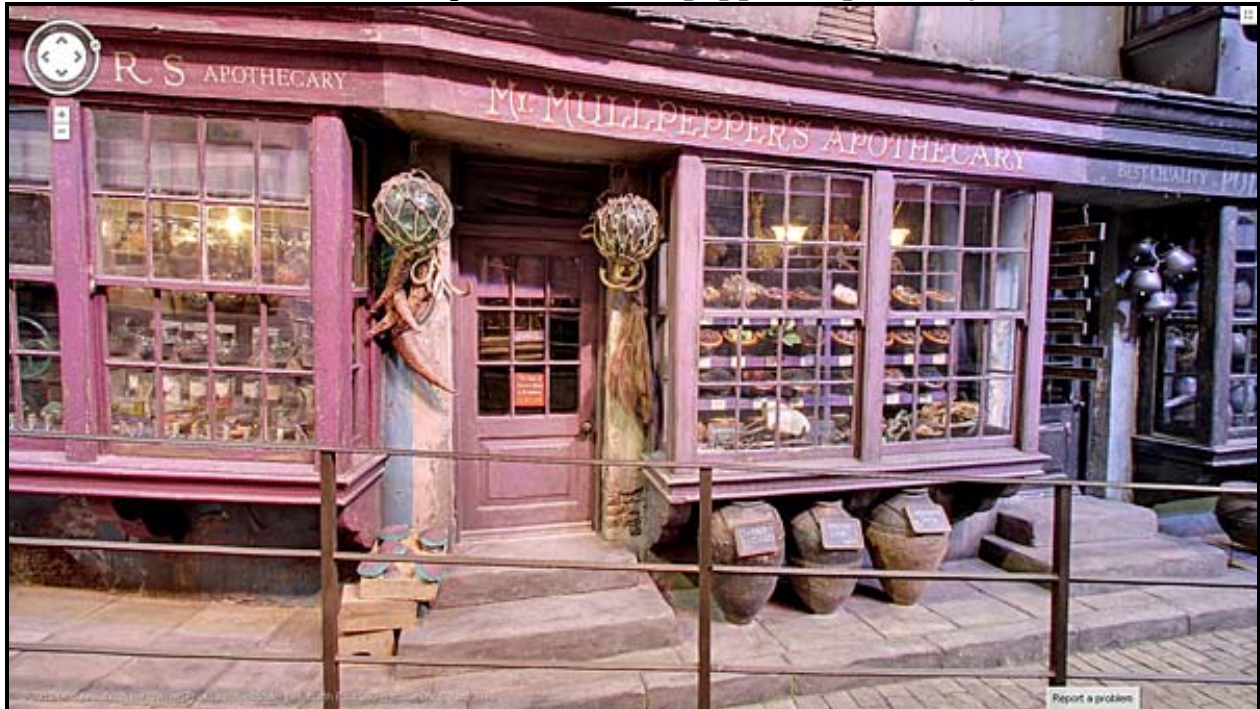


Madame Malkin's Fine Robes & Gowns ...
